1. MONITORING OF THE TERM 3 ASSESSMENT PLAN

7. GRADE 1 AND GRADE 8 ONLINE APPLICATIONS FOR 2027

8. NEW GRADE 2-7 ONLINE APPLICATIONS FOR 2027

Applications for new admissions in Grades 2-7 for 2027 is conducted online and opened on the 24TH of April 2026 and will conclude on the 28TH of August 2026. To apply, parents/guardians must go to our school website (www.midrandprimary.co.za) and click on the admissions tab. **Required documents:** Certified copy of birth certificate, certified copy of parent's IDs, recent/latest school report, municipality account/lease agreement, and the clinic card/records. Compulsory certified documents (not older than three months) must be scanned and uploaded. **Late applications will not be accepted.**
